The Preschool Children's Ministry is dedicated to supplementing the family in their endeavor to lay a spiritual foundation that will lead a child into a relationship with God through Jesus Christ. Specifically, our purpose is to provide ministry of the Word of God to children on their level so they can receive and to follow the Holy Spirit as He leads. This Team ministers to children ages' birth through Kindergarten. You must have attended HBCC for a period of six (6) months prior to applying to work with children or youth.
